## Monthly Musing Pillow Finishing instructions By Lonii Tingey for Shepherd's Bush

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## Materials Needed:

- 1 yard of small cording (size #150)
- 9" of a fabric (fabric closest to the design, cording, backing and tie)
- 9"X11" of coordinating fabric
- stuffing

## Instructions:

- 1. Measure out 3/4" from stitched design and trim off excess fabric.
- Cut four 1" strips of main fabric. (If it is a striped fabric, cut on the diagonal.)
- Starting with top and bottom strips, sew main strips to the edge of stitched piece.
- 4. Cut four 2"X 9" strips of coordinating fabric.
- 5. Starting again with top and bottom, sew coordinating fabric to main fabric.
- 6. Cut six 1 1/2" strips of main fabric for cording and tie.
- 7. Sew all strips together.
- Make your cording by sewing the cording into the strips by using your zipper foot.
- Use the rest of the main fabric for the tie. Sew down the edge, then turn and tie a bow in the middle. Set aside.
- 10. Pin cording to piece. (If you want it smaller, put the cording closer.)
- 11. Sew cording to piece.
- 12. Cut a piece for the back from the main fabric.
- 13. Attach the back leaving a small opening for stuffing.
- 14. Stuff pillow.
- 15. Stitch closed.
- 16. Attach tie to the back. We have sewn a button over each end on back.
- 17. Hang somewhere fun and enjoy!
