A. Hire fulltime/part time employee(s): As of right now we have four applications. Will set a date to review them and then set up interviews.

B. Window Tint on Apparatus Bay Doors: Leave on Shiloh still working on bids.

C. Weight Room Equipment Bids: Jorgensen's bid came in at \$119,327.40. Upper Limit-Tough Stuff equipment bid came in at \$101,864.30. Both warranties are identical. Upper Limit has 5 machines more than Jorgensen's. Both submitted a layout of the equipment and will work fine. Upper Limit has the State contract; this is why they are cheaper. Motion made by Gary to approve the lowest bid of Upper Limit for \$101,864.30, 2nd by Mike, Bryce Yes. Gary will notify Upper Limit and Shiloh will notify Jorgensen's.

D. Census: Deanna attended meeting on census. Seven were present in the meeting. They want 100 people to pass out the census and will pay \$13.50/hr. plus .58 cents a mile. Last census was in 2010. Only 40% of the residents in Garfield County were accounted for. Money can be used for senior citizen centers/assisted living center, day cares, Head Start programs, scholarships and grants, insurances etc. The census only has 9 questions and takes about 5 minutes per person. They do want age/gender on the census. The census is confidential for 72 years. Data will not be released. April 1st through July 10th is when they will do the count. They have only received 15 of the 100 applicants needed to take the surveys out. They want people to apply who can be trusted by communities. May have a committee station here at Ruby's to have people stop in at for questions or to fill out surveys. They are starting to advertise more for the positions. Will start training those hired in March 2020. They will hold another meeting hopping to get a better turn out. They will be in touch with Deanna.

Jean spoke with those that own ice rink in Cedar City working on 6-million-dollar facility, he will ask questions on operation and agreements.
