**B. 1 Year 5 Year Plans:** Reviewed last year's one year plans – Bryce Canyon Shuttle parking lot extension and General Plan. Five-year plan's included – Road extensions, Sidewalk curb & gutter, Recreation Center, Bike & Walking paths, Natural Gas from Panguitch, Stop Light Intersection by Car Care. Maybe add fire wildland truck to one year, Ron feels it may not work with CIB. In 2019 we will have our \$150,000 loan payment paid off. Council would like to leave the one-year plan empty for 2018, we do not have any current projects. On the Five-year plan - Have UDOT do a study on cross walks, and add cross walk in front of Car Care Center, add sidewalks, lighting & curb and gutter next on list, pave road to Skyler & Tim's house and road to employee housing, Shuttle parking extension. Leave the recreation center. Leave the bike walking paths, natural gas from Panguitch and stop light intersection. Need the recreation center to clear up bays in the fire house, it is getting full. Add a permanent clinic to Bryce City to the five-year list.

**C. Brock Syrett Eagle Project at the Town Park:** Brock has met with the Mayor and would like to add a drinking fountain near the restrooms and benches. \$2000 estimated costs for project. Brock would contact plumbers and coordinate installation. Have Brock bring in the final costs. Motion to approve made by Bryce, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike, Nick yes, Cherrie Yes, Gary yes

**5. Public Safety Building:** When lightning hit the building there was more damage to the generator than initially thought, current bill is \$7600 for the generator. May need to turn it over to the insurance. Fire Panel was about \$1500. Will be receiving a bill for the garage door as well. The lighting

hit approx. August 20<sup>th</sup>.

**7. Fire Department:** Ron has received a bid for Rebel Brush truck. Through the State contracting we can get a 2018, Ram 2500, diesel, \$47,000. Will take about 10 weeks to get the truck, then it will be taken to be equipped. Ron removed some items that are not necessary. Total bid to equip the truck approximately \$108,000. \$155,000 estimated for total cost of truck and equip. \$165,000 for other equipment to finish. Once it is ordered, Ron will meet with them prior to the building of the truck, then once again when the truck is complete. Truck should last 10 – 15 years. State bank offered 3.15% interest, 6 years in September. One annual payment a year, starting one year after loan closes. Payments will be about \$30,000 a year. Will be used for car crashes as well, not just fires. This will keep the fire truck from being damaged, add years to it. How does diesel pump work during the winter months? Would like to purchase next spring. Motion made by Mike to proceed on purchase not to exceed \$175,000, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Gary, Bryce Yes, Cherrie Yes, Nick Yes  
Ron ordered some turnout gear for Jesus Silva, he has been using Tropic hand me downs. Ron will meet with Shiloh about firefighters. Shortage of fire fighters in the area.
