4. Other Business:

A. Law Enforcement Contract with Garfield County: Sherriff Perkins has called and will put off the contract until business is back to normal. The council agrees maybe to pro-rate it when they want to start. Leave on agenda and discuss next meeting

B. COVID 19 Updates: South West Department of Health has started to allow gyms to open under certain regulations. They have posted regulations for different businesses throughout the state. The regulations were updated as of yesterday. Some of the regulations are -no guests can enter that present symptoms of COVID 19, people that come to gym can be screened by phone or in person, only 1 person allowed per 100 square feet (10x10 foot area). May have 4 people in the weight room. No team or group activities in the gym. Can use bathrooms but not locker rooms or showers. No touch pads or sign in sheets. Anyone over 60 not recommended to use the gym. In Garfield we have only had one case and it has been over two weeks and it was an out of town. Bryce makes motion to open the Wellness Center, 2nd by Mike, Gary yes, Cherrie Yes. We need to have new rules – have people sign up for a time slot. Whatever works well for Taryn. If it becomes an issue, then we can address. Can the council let people in when Taryn is not around? Yes, may be a good idea. Taryn won't turn keys on, we will have to let guests in so we can monitor. Taryn won't be here on the weekends, but can let people in from 8AM-5PM weekly. Open temporarily from 8AM-5PM, closed on weekends for now then we will see how many are utilizing it. Have open hours but they need to sign up for times with Taryn. Keep machines sanitized – Taryn has signs in there on how to sanitize. Add the new rules to the Facebook page. Use extra precautions when using the gym and sanitize, sanitize and sanitize. Need to keep social distancing
