4. Other Business

- A. Balloon Rally Representation:** Lori Talbot in attendance to talk about Balloon Rally. The rally ranges from 6,000 to 8,000 people per year. All balloon pilots on board for this year's rally. Mayor has addressed concerns with main street committee. Things have been repaired. Ruby's will continue to have balloon glows, and Lori does not feel there will be any problems going forward. Bryce City is always willing to work with other communities, we would like to see the same support from Panguitch. Motion to approve the \$1000 sponsorship made by Gary, 2nd by Mike, Nick yes, Cherrie Yes, Bryce absent. Sponsorship includes balloon ride for two, banner with logo, invitation for six to Thursday dinner, four 20 second radio ads, name on official event poster, and sponsor logo on website
- B. Road Paving Bid:** Holbrook bid \$127,239.76, need to get one other bid before final approval can be made. Have Bryce follow up on other bids.
- C. Planning Commission Compensation Ordinance:** Tim put in ordinance that they are requesting \$20.00 per hour, paid on July 1st of each year. Must be in attendance, they have five members. Tim is the chairman. The commission does meet twice a month. Council recommending payment per meeting rather than hour. Need to have a public hearing on the ordinance. They are working on general plan and zoning.
- D. Canyon to Canyon Bike Race:** Deanna met with LEPC, they are on board with the race. South West Health Department has helmets, and would like to setup their own booth and have helmets available. Permits are complete with BCNP. Deanna met with Cindy and Jan. They thought all looked well with the application. Rangers are concerned with where ambulance can respond. County will have ATV's, rangers, other vehicles available. Sargent Cox and Sherriff Perkins will cover law enforcement. Contact Joe Thompson to add online when he does the half marathon advertisement. Where are the funds going if there are any left over? Will have to purchase the t-shirts. Registration fee is \$30.00 for the Park Pass, need to have a minimal registration fee on top of it, poker run will have an additional fee. Tour of Utah and Bike Utah may donate towards the race. Deanna will follow up with them. Paul from Forest Service said it wouldn't be an issue with the permit, Nick filled out the permit. Deanna will follow up with Forest Service. Syd filled paperwork with the Cities Insurance.
