There is funding available under the Outdoor Rec grant. We can apply for this funding for anything outdoor; bike paths, walking trails, off road bike trails, golf course, 3D archery, rifle range etc. It is a matching grant, would have to have funds ready to match. They focus on multi use unique outdoor options. Do we need to meet with the Forest Service on future projects?
