ORDINANCE 395-17

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING FIRE/EMS IMPACT FEES

WHEREAS, West Bountiful City previously adopted Ordinance 349-12 – “An Ordinance Adopting an Impact Fee Facilities plan for Fire/EMS Impact Fees, A Written Analysis of Fire/EMS Impact Fees; Enacting Impact Fees; and Establishing a Service Area for Purposes of Equitable Distribution of the Impact Fee”; and


WHEREAS, the South Davis Metro Fire Service Area, a local district and service area, now has authority to implement impact fees for its own purposes; and

WHEREAS, West Bountiful City entered into an Interlocal Agreement Related to the Provision of Fire Suppression and Emergency Medical Services, wherein it agreed to repeal the city’s Fire/EMS impact fees once the South Davis Metro Fire Service Area implemented its own impact fees; and

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2017 the South Davis Metro Fire Service Area adopted Impact Fee Resolution 2017-03 – “A Resolution Adopting a Impact Fee Facilities Plan for Fire/EMS Impact Fees, A Written Analysis of Fire/EMS Impact Fees, and Enacting Impact Fees,” which will take effect September 17, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WEST BOUNTIFUL CITY COUNCIL THAT ORDINANCE 349-12 PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED IMPOSING FIRE/EMS IMPACT FEES IS HEREBY REPEALED IN ITS ENTIRETY.

ADOPTED this 19th day of September, 2017. This Ordinance will become effective upon signing and posting.
