Bountiful Irrigation REMINDERS—No Outside Watering Between 10:00AM to 6:00PM



- Place a small can on your lawn and time how long it takes to get ½" of water in it from your sprinklers. This is the longest time you would need to water on each of two or three days a week during the hottest part of the summer.

-Water usage by lawns and gardens is substantially less in the spring and the fall than it is in July and August. Don't forget to change your routine or your automatic sprinklers accordingly.

800 West Improvement Project

The project consists of replacing the 70 year old cast iron water line with a new larger 12" PVC water pipe that is much more reliable and improves water quality. Installing a new storm drain system to help with drainage. Curb & Gutter on both sides of 800 West from 400 North to Pages Lane. The roadway will be excavated to a depth of 25" below existing road and then rebuilt & repaved.

1000 North thru 1600 North paved by July 1st & 400 North thru 1000 North paved by Aug 25th

Code Red is an automated notification system the city can use to make contact in the event of an emergency. CodeRED can reach West Bountiful residents and businesses by residential phone, business phone, cell phone, text message and email.

It is best to register your email and phone on the website and download the app for notifications.

All residential phone numbers (landlines) in the CodeRED database are automatically enrolled to receive emergency notifications from the City of West Bountiful. You cannot opt-out of emergency messages. These will include urgent updates on natural disasters, public health outbreaks, snow emergencies, water boil orders, evacuation notices, parking bans, missing children, law enforcement activities, hazardous materials situations and any other incident requiring immediate action. You will only receive emergency messages that are applicable to your address.
