## "Stormy Stars"

Class: Saturday November 17, 2018 at Olde City Quilts
Pattern by Deb Tucker / Studio 180 Design
This is a twist on the traditional 'Storm at Sea' pattern.
Careful placement of fabric value, make some stars stand out, while others recede into the 'background'. It is truly a stunning quilt!

## REQUIRED FOR CLASS:

Studio 180 Design tools:
Diamond Rect and Square Squared (either size) tools.
"Stormy Stars" pattern (All tools and pattern will be available for purchase before class; NO copies / sharing of pattern allowed!! This is illegal).

General sewing supplies: new needle in machine; thread; scissors, marking tool; rotary cutter (new blade suggested); seam ripper, FINE pins suggested....etc.


Project size: $51 \times 69$ inches
Fabric VALUE is very important in this project. You need three main colors; one color needs a light, medium and dark. The other color needs a light and a dark. Plus white (or very light of third color).

My sample has blue, purple and white. Blue has light, medium and dark. Purple has light and dark; and white is also used.

Fabric requirements and cutting instructions are on the back of this page.
Please PRE-CUT and LABEL Unit letters (A, B, C, etc) before coming to class. There is a lot to do in class, you must precut BEFORE CLASS to save time.

|  | C |  | Diamond Side Triangles: | Cut 2 strips: 4" x wof; sub-cut into 14 rectangles 2-3/4 44 inches |
| Medium Blue | G | 3/4 yards | Round 2 Side Triangles: | Cut 3 strip: 4-1/4" $\times$ wof; sub-cut into 24 squares: $4-1 / 4$ inches; cut once diagonally to yield 48 triangles |
|  | F |  | Sq Sq Side Triangles: | Cut 3 strips 2-3/4" x wof; sub-cut into 34 squares $2-3 / 4$ "; cut once diagonally into 68 triangles. |
| Light Blue | $A \& B$ | 1-1/4 yards | Diamond Side Triangles: | Cut 4 strips: 4 " $x$ wof; sub-cut into 58 rectangles 2-3/4 $\times 4$ inches |
|  | G |  | Round 1 Side Triangles: | Cut 4 Strips $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof; sub-cut into 48 squares $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$; cut once diagonally to yield 96 triangles |
| Dark Purple | B \& C | 1-1/8 yards | Center Diamonds: | Cut 5 strips: 3-1/4" $\times$ wof |
|  | E |  | Center Squares: | Cut 1 strip: 2-3/4" x wof |
|  | G |  | Round 2 Side Triangles: | Cut 2 strip $4-1 / 4$ " $x$ wof; sub-cut into 12 squares $4-1 / 4$ inches; cut once diagonally to yield 24 triangles |
|  |  |  | Border Folded Corners: <br> ${ }^{* *}$ OR IF using Corner Pop tool: | ** 2 Options** <br> Cut 2 strips 3-1/2 x wof ; sub-cut into 24 squares 3-1/2 inches <br> **OR Cut 2 strips 4-1/4" x wof; Cut 12 squares 4-1/4 inches; cut once diagonally yield 24 triangles |
| Light Purple | G | 3/8 yard | Center Squares: | Cut 2 strips 3-1/2" x wof; sub-cut into 24 squares 3-1/2 inches |
| White | $A, B \& C$ | 1-1/8 yards | Diamond Side Triangles: | Cut 6 strips $4 " x$ wof; sub-cut into 72 rectangles 2-3/4 44 inches |
|  | D \& E |  | Sq Sq Triangles: | Cut 3 strips 2-3/4" x wof; sub-cut into 36 squares $2-3 / 4$ inches; cut once diagonally to yield 72 triangles |
| Backing |  | 4 yards |  | (not needed for class) |
