## SUPPLY LIST

FABRIC: THIS IS THE FABRIC REQUIRMENTS FOR THE WHOLE QUILT. FOR JUST THE BLOCK YOU CAN USE SMALLER RANDOM PIECES IF YOU WISH TO MAKE PRACICE BLOCKS -

PLEASE SEE THE PRECUTTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRECUTTING THE FABRICS FOR ONE BLOCK OF EACH DESIGN WHICH IS WHAT WE WILL BE WORKING ON DURING THE CLASS TIME.
$\square \quad 1 / 2$ yard - Background for butterfly and tulip block
$\square \quad 1 / 4$ yard or Fat Quarters for other parts of all the blocks -8 colors will be plenty, but using more can be fun $\odot$

## BASIC SUPPLIES:

$\square \quad$ Rotary cutter, 28 mm or 45 mm sizeRotary mat: Mat $12^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ recommended - please bring your own for this technique a small mat is required, anything larger will just be too big.
$\square \quad$ Add-a-Quarter Ruler - 6" or 12 '

$\square \quad 100 \%$ Cotton 50 Weight piecing thread - neutral colorFine pins
$\square \quad$ Spray Sizing
Seam Guilds from Guildlines4Quilters. These are the perfect tool for making the perfect scant $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
