



Advanced Machine Quilting w/Westalee Rulers

Class Supply List

Class Description:

In class we will work with Westalee rulers and concentrate on ruler quilting. This is an advanced class, you will need to be a confident machine quilter and have your sewing machine in great working condition. There is homework that must be completed prior to coming to class, in order to get the most out of your day.

Supplies:

Sewing Machine in good working order. You will need to have a thorough knowledge of machine quilting on your sewing machine.

- Westalee "Quilt as you go" Ruler Set (**Required**)
- Supreme or Sew Steady Free Motion Glider (**Required**)
- Sew Steady Extension table that fits your sewing machine (**Required**)
- Thread – bright color (50 wt) + several wound bobbins
- 80/12 Metallic Topstitch Needles
- Quilting Gloves
- Frixion pen
- (6-8) Safety pins
- (1) 18" x 22 - "quilt sandwich" for optional practice
- Scissors – hand snips are great
- Basic Sewing Kit

Before Class:

In order to be confident and avoid frustration during class, you will need to make sure that you have the correct quilting foot for your sewing machine!

You will receive a quilting foot in your ruler kit set, when ordering you will need to specify if your machine is a low, mid or high shank. It is very helpful to watch You Tube video – Westalee Ruler Foot for Domestic Machines – or – go to www.westalee.com. My Bernina 530 uses a #77 adapter foot (low shank), a Pfaff will use a mid shank foot. If your sewing machine is another brand, you will need to contact where you purchased your machine to get the correct foot/information.

Before class put your new quilting foot on your sewing machine and practice with a ruler to get comfortable. These two steps will save a lot of frustration and allow you to get right to quilting in class with your new rulers.
