Throw Size 54 x 66

## **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:**

**#1 Fabric** (Blue & Yellow Print): Cut 1 - 10 1/2" square for <u>Center</u>. <u>2nd Border</u>: Cut 2 - 3 1/2" x 30 1/2" strip and 2 - 5 1/2" x 32 1/2" strip.


**#2 Fabric** (Dark Blue): Cut 4 squares 5 7/8". Cut in 1/2 diagonally for 8 triangles.

3rd Border: Cut 2 - 5 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips and 2 - 7 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips.

#3 Fabric (Light Blue): Cut 4 - 3" squares. Cut 8 - 3 3/8" squares and cut in 1/2 diagonally for 16 triangles. Cut 1 - 6 1/4" square and cut in 1/2 diagonally twice for 4 triangles. 4th Border: Cut 5 - 2 -1/2" x 44" strips. Piece sides to measure 54-1/2". Piece top and bottom to measure 46-1/2".

**#4 Fabric** (Pale Yellow): Cut 4 - 3" squares. Cut 8 - 3 3/8" squares and cut in 1/2 diagonally for 16 triangles. Cut 1 - 6 1/4" square and cut in 1/2 diagonally twice for 4 triangles.

<u>1st Border</u>: Cut 2 - 3 1/2" x 20 1/2" strips and 2 - 5 1/2" x 26 1/2" strips.



5th Border: Cut 6 - 4 1/2" x 44". Piece sides to measure 58-1/2". Piece top and bottom to measure 54-1/2"

## **SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Sew together 8 triangles of Fabric #3 and #4 into 3" blocks.

2. Sew together the 8 blocks from Step 1 with 3" squares of Fabric #3 and #4. Press. These are the corner blocks.

3. Take the four large triangles of Fabric #4 and sew to each side a small triangle of Fabric #3. Make 4 Press.


4. Sew to each side of (4) triangle sets from Step 3 another small triangle of Fabric #3. Press.

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5. Sew to the top a large triangle of Fabric #4. Press.



6. Sew to each side a large triangle of Fabric #2. Press.



7. Sew together two triangle units to the sides of the center square. Now sew together one triangle set with two corner sets. Repeat. Sew to the top and bottom of square. Press.





8. Sew on borders. See cutting instructions for the border measurements and order. Always sew on the side first - then the top and bottom. Press. Quilt as desired.
