

Quilty Magnets

Inspired by Cory Yoder's Quilt Magnets tutorial on YouTube in February 2025, this set of Quilty Magnets can be completed entirely in the hoop. Each one takes less than 15 minutes of stitching time. All designs are digitized by Diane Comeau, CaDi Corners, LLC.



Materials/Tools Needed for Each Quilty Square or Round Magnet:

(2) 3 ½" Squares Backing Fabric (PREP: Fold in half Right Side Out and Press) **[4 ½" squares for the Round Magnets]**

(1) 3 ½" Square Background Fabric (PREP: Fuse SF101 to wrong side of Background) **[4 ½" square for the Round Magnets]**

(1) 3 ½" Square SF101 **[4 ½" squares for the Round Magnets]**

(1) 2 ½" Square of Batting (Optional) **[4" square for the Round Magnets]**

Medium to Heavy Cut-Away or Tear-Away Stabilizer (1 per Magnet)

¾" Ceramic Magnet (Strong)

Corner Turner

Hot Glue Gun or Fabric Glue

Embroidery Thread













Step1:

These steps are the same for all blocks.

1. Hoop Stabilizer and stitch placement stitch.
2. **OPTIONAL:** Cover Placement stitch with Batting; Stitch Batting Tack Down; TRIM Batting close to stitching. ***Skip this thread color if not using batting.***
3. Place Background over shape; Stitch Basting stitch.

STEP 2 – Block Detail Stitching:

These steps vary from block to block:

STEP 3:

These steps are the same for each block:

1. Alignment Stitches:
 - a. Fold the Backing Fabric right sides out and align the fold with the Alignment stitches with the excess fabric covering the right side of the design.
2. Stitch the RIGHT Side Backing down.
3. Alignment Stitches
 - a. Place the final folded backing fabric aligning the fold with the alignment stitches making sure the excess fabric covers the LEFT side of the design.
4. Stitch the LEFT side Backing down.
5. Stitch the Final Closing Seam.

Remove from the hoop. Trim the excess fabric and snip the corners. Turn Right Side Out. Use a corner-turner to help achieve a sharp point in each corner. Press.

Finishing Step – Secure Magnet and Close Back opening:

1. Make sure the strongest side of the magnet is facing you; Open the Envelope opening to expose the center of the back of the design and place a drop of hot glue. Then quickly press the magnet and allow it to cool.
2. Select a method that works best for you to close the Quilty Magnet:
 - a. OPTIONAL: Place a drop of hot glue onto the side of the magnet facing you and pull the backing side closest to the magnet over to secure.
 - b. OPTIONAL: Run a scant line of hot glue down the opening and secure both sides of the backing.
 - c. OPTIONAL: Whip Stitch the closing.
