PLEASE NOTE change from regular date and time for September through December classes:

September 25, 1:30 October 18, 5:00 November 15, 1:30 December 13, 5:00 CLASS POLICIES: Classes are reserved on a first-come basis. Pre-registration is required. Full class fee is due at time of registration. The cost of supplies is not included in the class fee unless so stated in the class description. Class fee is non-refundable unless you cancel at least 7 days prior to the first class session. We will cancel the class if less than the minimum number of students is registered 5 days before the class begins. If we cancel the class, the fee will be refunded.

**PURCHASES DURING CLASS:** Receive a 10% discount off purchases of \$10 or more during class. (Does not apply to class fees or gift certificates).

**DAY OF CLASS REGISTRATION BONUS:** On the day that you sign up for a class you are entitled to receive 20% off of the fabric purchased for that class.
