Francis Frontier Days began as a small group of cowboys, farmers and the local 4-H Club wanting a place to meet, ride, talk, share stories and just have some fun. The local 4-H Club held many fundraisers to raise the money needed to build the arena that we currently use. The Town received some grant money and many citizens in the community volunteered time and materials to build and install the chutes. Once complete, they held activities such as wild cow milking, team roping, and games for the kids to enjoy.

In 1983, Francis Town decided that it would hold a day of celebration every year on Labor Day. From those humble beginnings, Francis Town has grown into Francis City. The event has grown from a small one-day celebration into a four-day celebration. As the city has evolved, so have the ideas and activities held.

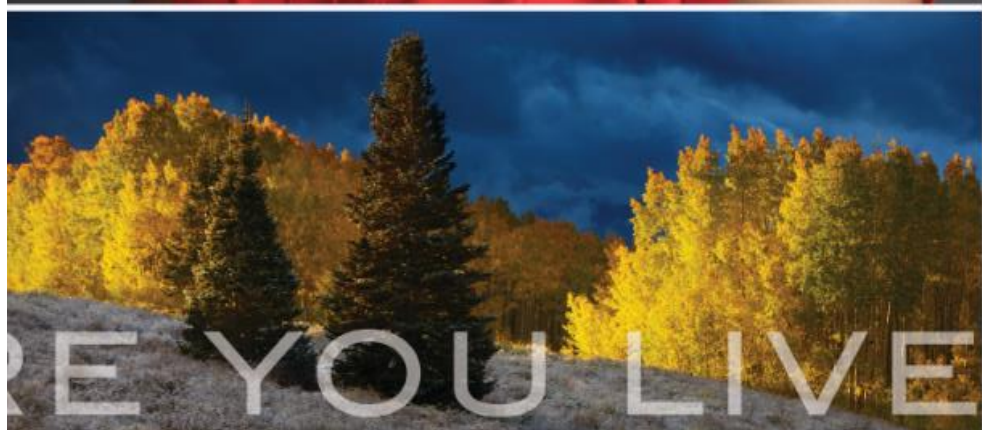

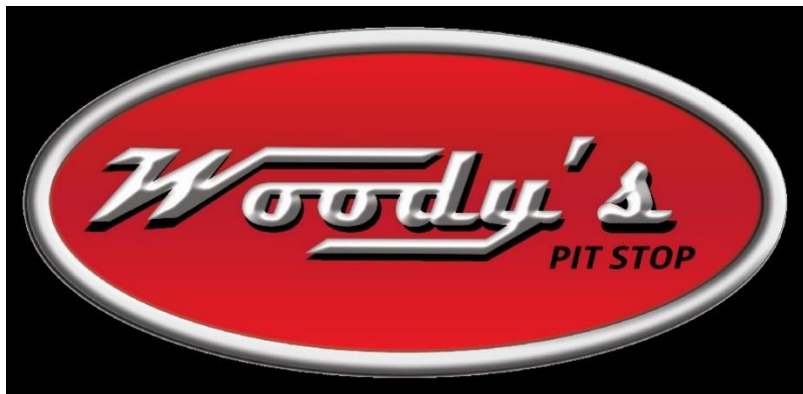
