1. Welcome, Call to Order--- It is Thursday June 24th, 2021, this Emergency City Council Meeting is to enact Ordinance 2021-12 to enact an Ordinance to prevent any fireworks of any kind. The fire conditions are extreme, and the City feels that they need to enact this Ordinance to restrict personal fireworks use. This Ordinance would be in place until the end of October 2021 and then it will automatically cease.

5. Discussion, Updates and Approval on Potential Action Items

A. City Restriction on the Use of Personal Fireworks---Ordinance 2021-12—The Mayor explained there are two ordinances to choose from in regard to fireworks, he then read each Ordinance. One has a Class B misdemeanor penalty, plus they would be responsible for all damages. The Mayor reviewed both versions of the Ordinance with all in attendance. He explained this means no sparklers, poppers, snakes or any such firework.

The Mayor motioned to enact Ordinance 2021-12, An Ordinance of the City Council of Francis City Restricting the use of Personal Fireworks Within All Portions of the City. Councilmember Cox seconded the motion. The Mayor and all Councilmembers voted Aye; motion passed.

6. Meeting Adjourned--- Councilmember Fryer motioned to adjourn. Councilmember Forman seconded the motion. Everyone is favor; meeting adjourned.
