

Francis Frontier Days
2019 Rodeo Queen Rules

1. Contestant must be at least 13 years old but not more than 21 years old as of the day of the Queen Contest (the "Contest"), **June 1, 2019**.
2. Contestant shall be enrolled in school and not be on any type of probation at the time of entrance in the Contest. A Contestant is not disqualified under this rule if she has graduated from high school at the time of entrance in the Contest and meets all of the remaining qualifications for entrance in the Contest.
3. Every Contestant must abide by the dress code. If there are any violations of the dress code there will be a 50% deduction of the violating Contestant's entire score.
4. The dress code for Contestant is as follows: Contestant is required to wear black Wrangler or Cruel Girl jeans, long-sleeved white button-up or snap western blouse, western hat (any color, no straw), and boots. No satin or silk blouses are permitted. No revealing or transparent blouses will be permitted. Ties and accessories are permitted as suitable attire. Vests, chaps, gloves and suits are not permitted. The same outfit must be worn during the indoor portions of the contest as well as the outdoor horsemanship judging event.
5. Contestant must give a 2-3-minute speech. The topic for the speech is: **Traditions of the American West**. Contestant must complete modeling pattern (approximately 1 minute), impromptu question (to be chosen at random by judges the day of Contest), and interview.
6. Contestant must raise at least \$100 sponsorship for Francis Frontier Days, to be turned into the Francis Frontier Days Committee at the time of entry application, but no later than the day of the Contest.
7. Successful Contestants who are selected to be the Francis Frontier Days Rodeo Queen and 1st and 2nd Attendants must participate as the reigning Rodeo Royalty over the Francis Frontier Days Rodeo and other Labor Day activities including the parade, grand entry of the arena events, help at horse games, junior rodeo and other events during the Francis Frontier Days as requested by the Frontier Days Committee.
8. The Francis Frontier Days Royalty must be available to represent Francis Frontier Days at the following events:
 - a. Oakley 4th of July Parade and Rodeo
 - b. Kamas Valley Fiesta Days Parade and Rodeo
 - c. Summit County Fair Parade and Rodeo
 - d. At least two (2) RMPRA Rodeos
 - e. Any other function(s) that the Frontier Days Committee deem(s) appropriate
9. Contestants, including those crowned as royalty, will be disqualified for the following:
 - a. If crowned as Francis Frontier Days Rodeo Queen, you try out for another contest during the year of reign.
 - b. Contestant or someone acting on behalf of Contestant, including Contestant's family and/or friends, attempts to influence or affect the decision of any of the judges through any conduct, action or words other than her official presentations made in front of the entire panel of judges during the Queen Contest.
 - c. Contestant or her family members, sponsors, coaches, committee and/or friends cause any disturbance to the Rodeo Queen Contest proceedings with any act of misconduct.
 - d. Contestant fails to fulfill obligations as directed by the Francis Frontier Days Committee.
 - e. Contestant is a family member of a Francis City Councilor.
10. If any member of the Rodeo Royalty fails to fulfill any of her obligations as a royalty member, she will lose her title and be required to return all prizes.
11. Contestant (or their parent or legal guardian if Contestant is under the age of 18) must sign a waiver of liability for any injury suffered by Contestant as a result of, or while participating in, any pageant or Francis Frontier Days Rodeo Queen activity.
12. Contestant agrees and acknowledges that Francis Frontier Days Committee or Queen Contest judges, by majority vote, may disqualify any contestant for failure to abide by or meet the Contestant requirements. Further, the Francis Frontier Days Committee, by majority vote, may also disqualify a Contestant, Queen or Attendant for conduct unbecoming of a representative of, or embarrassing to the City of Francis as a member of the Rodeo Royalty.
13. Any royalty member who does not abide by these rules will forfeit her title and the contestant next in line will be granted her title in place of the forfeiting Contestant.
14. All decisions by the judges and the Francis Frontier Days Committee in regards to the Francis Frontier Days Rodeo Queen Contest are final and not subject to review.

2019 Rodeo Queen Contract

The following outlines:

- A. Commitments you make if selected as a member of the Francis Frontier Days Rodeo Royalty;
- B. Information regarding other awards, prizes, and scholarships; and,
- C. Photographs and promotional releases.

Before you sign this Contract, please read it carefully and ask any questions you may have about the commitments you are making.

A. If I am selected as Francis Frontier Days Rodeo Queen or a member of the Royalty:

- 1. If selected as Francis Frontier Days Rodeo Queen, I will serve until my successor is selected or appointed. I agree to not try out for another contest during my reign.
- 2. If selected as an attendant, I will be available to assume all of the rights and obligations of Francis Frontier Days Rodeo Queen, as set forth herein, if for any reason the original Francis Frontier Days Rodeo Queen or the prior attendants are unable or ineligible to.
- 3. I will attend and fully participate in the following mandatory events:
 - a. Francis Frontier Days Rodeo and other celebration activities (which may include, but are not limited to: parade, grand entry of arena events, horse games, junior rodeo, and any other events during the Francis Frontier Days as requested by the Frontier Days Committee) commencing **August 30, 2019 and ending September 2, 2019.**
 - b. Oakley Rodeo and 4th of July Celebration (parade and rodeo)
 - c. Kamas Valley Fiesta Days (parade and rodeo)
 - d. Summit County Fair (parade and rodeo)
 - e. At least two (2) RMPRA Rodeos (which can include Francis Frontier Days and Kamas Fiesta Days)
 - f. Any other function(s) that the Frontier Days Committee deem(s) appropriate.
- 4. I agree to represent Francis Frontier Days Rodeo Royalty with the highest moral character both in my personal capacity and my official capacity, whether in Francis City or out of Francis City, whether wearing my crown or other insignia of Francis Frontier Days Rodeo Royalty or not.

B. I will use my scholarship to defray expenses relating to the pursuit of academic advancement.

- 1. While in high school, scholarships may be used to pay fees for academic purposes such as AP class fees, concurrent enrollment, college admissions tests, college preparation or admissions testing courses, tutoring, college or university admissions costs, college admissions tests, and purchase of books and materials required for academic classes. They may not be used to pay for extracurricular fees not relating to academic purposes such as yearbooks, activity cards, cheerleading, band, etc.
- 2. Following high school graduation, scholarships may be used for fees relating to attendance at an accredited academic university or college or trade technology school including, but not limited to admissions tests, admissions costs, tuition, books, housing expenses, tutoring, and meal plans (if staying in dorms or onsite housing).
- 3. Other expenses may be considered by the Francis Frontier Days Committee at the Committee's discretion.
- 4. Request for scholarship payment are to be submitted to the Committee and should include documentation of all expenses (such as a bill, statement, or invoice) totaling the sum of the scholarship. Request for scholarship payment may also be made directly from the Committee to the academic institution if written notification is provided to the Committee with a minimum of 30 days' notice.

C. I authorize the Francis Frontier Days Committee to take any photograph(s) or video(s) of me to use for promotional purposes.

- 1. The Committee may take and use photograph(s) or video(s) of me for use and re-use in an edited or unedited manner for any purpose. All photographs and videos become and remain the property of the Francis Frontier Days in perpetuity and may be used and re-used for publicity, advertising, or any other proper use. This provision shall specifically survive termination of this Contract.

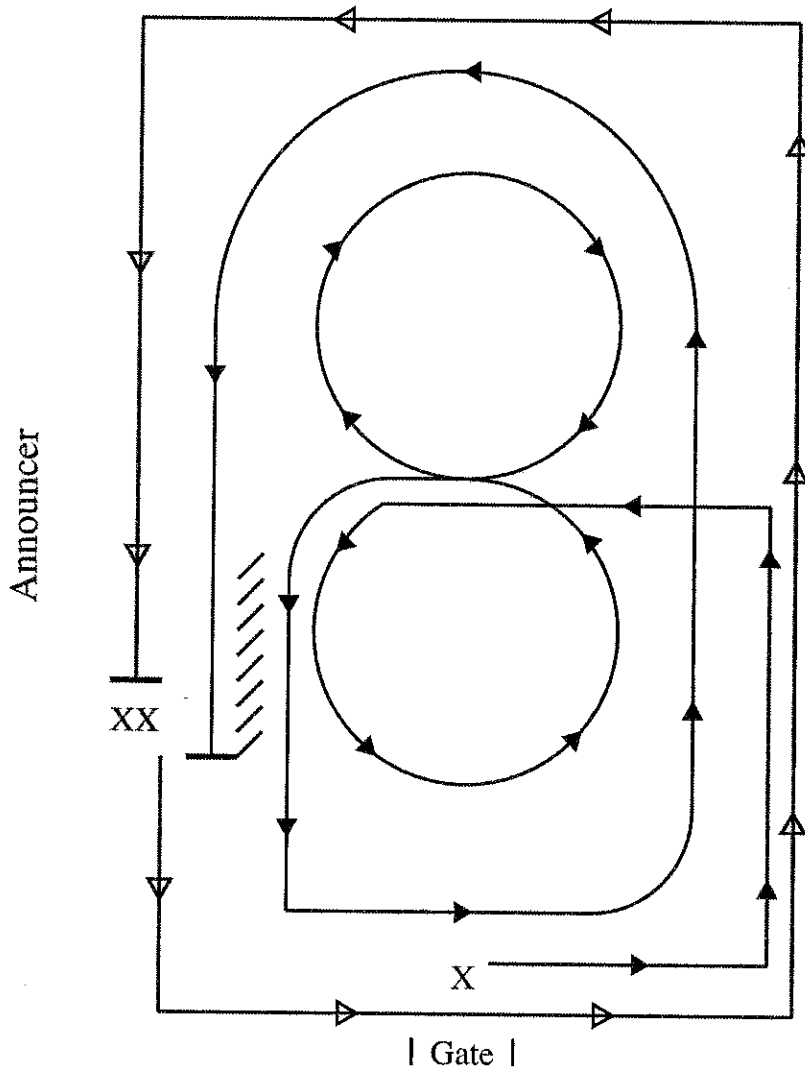

2019 Francis Frontier Days Queen Pattern



Horsemanship Pattern:

1. Lead horse into the arena
2. Mount X
3. Walk near fence to the right until you reach the corner of the arena
4. Do extended jog/trot along side of the arena, turn to center
5. Begin lope at center of arena and lope left circle on left lead
6. Change leads at center of arena and lope right circle on right lead
7. Change leads and continue loping around end of arena
8. Once on the straight, increase speed and continue around end of arena
9. Slide stop and back two full horse lengths //////////////
10. Presentation ride (start and stop in same place)
11. Slide stop, settle
12. Dismount and walk horse out of the arena XX
