Unit C

Cut:

2 – 4 ½" strips by WOF Fabric 1

2 – 2 ½" strips by WOF Fabric 2

2 - 2 ½" strips by WOF Fabric 3

Sew in this order:

Sew a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of Fabric 2 to the 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of Fabric 1. Then add the 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of Fabric 3 to the 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 1.

Cut unit C into (20) 2 1/2" units

Using Units A, make 30 4-patch squares, alternating the colors: Fabric 1 and Fabric 3 These are 4-patch A



4-patch A

4-Patch B

Using **Units B, make 12 4-patch squares**, alternating Units B, make 12 4-patch squares the colors Fabric 1 and Fabric 2 **These are 4-patch B and will be used in Clue #4** 

Also cut Fabric 2 into (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips and subcut into 12 4 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles.

Unit D

Add a 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle to the 12 Unit B 4-patch squares. Fabric #1 2 ½" squares are to the left.



Make 12 of each



Make sure that Color #1 is in the same position. The example below is incorrect.
