Unit C

Cut:
$2-41 / 2 \prime$ strips by WOF Fabric 1
$2-21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips by WOF Fabric 2
$2-21 / 2 \prime \prime$ strips by WOF Fabric 3

Sew in this order:

Cut unit C into (20) $21 / 2 \prime$ " units

Using Units A , make 30 4-patch squares, alternating the colors: Fabric 1 and Fabric 3 These are 4-patch A


Using Units B, make 12 4-patch squares, alternating Units B, make 12 4-patch squares the colors Fabric 1 and Fabric 2 These are 4-patch B and will be used in Clue \#4

Also cut Fabric 2 into (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips and subcut into $124 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

Unit D
Add a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the 12 Unit B 4-patch squares. Fabric \#1 $21 / 2 \prime$ " squares are to the left.
