

FALL MYSTERY QUILT

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

WOF = Width of Fabric

HST = Half Square Triangles

Let's get started.

Clue 1: Gathering the fabrics.

You will need 5 fabrics: Medium-dark blue; orange or bright red; white; light blue; medium blue.

The blues should be all in the same family, that is, all pure blue, or all blue/green...the pure blue works best.

Requirements:

Fabric A – medium/dark blue: $2\frac{1}{2}$ yards

Fabric B – orange or bright red: $\frac{7}{8}$ yard

Fabric C – white: $2\frac{1}{4}$ yards

Fabric D – Light blue: 1 yard

Fabric E – Medium blue: 1 yard.



There are many pieces to cut in this quilt and I suggest that as you cut them, you place them in a plastic bag (I use zip-lock type bags) and label them. I will give you the label names with the cutting instructions.

Rather than cutting all the fabrics at once, we will cut them as we need them for each block.

Please make sure that **if you have any partial strips left over, that you save them...do not throw them away as they will be used in later steps.**

Block #1 – uses Fabric D – Light Blue

Cut (8) 4 ½" strips X WOF (Width of fabric)

Sub cut into (20) 4 ½" x 8 ½". Label these 4.5x8.5 B1 (size + block number)

NOTE: you are not using all 8 strips for the 8 ½" rectangles. Block #2 also uses these strips.

Block #2- uses Fabric D – light blue

Cut (20) 4 ½" x 4 ½" squares Label these 4.5x4.5 B2

Set these pieces aside.
