

Fall Mystery Quilt

Clue 4

Get out your sewing machines, we are ready to roll!

As always, use a ¼" seam allowance. When sewing fabrics together, sew with right sides together. I highly suggest pressing after each sewing.


Let's construct Section 1 of the quilt. These blocks will be set together in columns, rather than rows. The columns will then be sewn together to make the Section 1.

Column 1

1. Choose your package labeled 4.5x4.5B4 Color D (light blue) and also the one labeled 4.5x8.5B4B. You also need the windmill blocks (blue/white) which were made in Clue 2.
2. Sew a windmill block to the bottom of the light blue 4 ½" x 8 ½" rectangle.

Column 2

3. Find your red/orange and darkest blue HST (half square triangle) which we made in Clue 3. Sew the following: Start off with a 4" x 4" light blue square (Color D). Sew a windmill block to the bottom of the light blue square. * Add a 4 ½" x 4 ½" dark blue square to the bottom of the windmill. **MAKE 10** using the dark blue square. Call this Column 2A



4. Make 10 more blocks following the directions in #3 **EXCEPT** use the 10 red/blue HST as the bottom block. * Add a red/blue HST to the bottom of the windmill. Call this Column 2B



Column 3

5. This is your last cut: From Color A (dark blue), cut (4) 4 ½” strips.
Subcut into (20) 4 ½” x 8 ½” rectangles.
6. Sew a windmill to the 4 ½” end of the 4 ½” x 8 ½” rectangles you just cut.

Finish the Section 1:

1. Sew Column 1 to Column **2A** (has solid dark blue square at the bottom); add column 3. Make 10 of these.
2. Sew Column 1 to Column **2B** (column **2B** has the red/blue half square triangle at the bottom); add column 3. Make 10

YAHOO! We finished SECTION 1. On to Section 2 next week with Clue 5 and finish the quilt with Clue 6.
