


FALL MYSTERY QUILT Clue #6

You are ready to put your quilt together and to add the borders.

First, cut the borders. You will need (8) 2 1/5" strips of color B (red/orange) and (8) 3" strips of color A (dark blue)

There are 3 basic blocks: The pinwheel block that is all blues – call this BLUE
The pinwheel blocks that has the red triangle at the bottom – call this RED
The SNOWMAN block.



RED



BLUE

There are 6 rows – 5 blocks across.

Row 1: Red block, Blue block, red block, blue, red

Row 2: Snowman, Red block, Snowman, Red Block, Snowman

Row 3: Red block, Snowman, Red Block, Snowman, Red Block

Row 4: Repeat row 2 - *****At this point you should have used up all your Red Blocks

Row 5: ~~Repeat row 3~~ Blue block, Snowman, Blue Block, Snowman, Blue block

Row 6: Blue, Blue, Blue, Blue, Blue



Add the red border first, then finish with the dark blue border.



You may wish to add eyes and a carrot nose to the snowman as well as 3 buttons down the front.

Options: Use little black button for the eyes and buttons, use a carrot button for the nose.

OR Embroider the eyes, nose, and buttons

OR Applique the details on your snowman (sorry I'm not going to do this)

OR Use fusible web such as Steam-A-Seam to fusible applique the eyes, nose and buttons (this will be my preferred choice.)

OR Draw the eyes, nose and buttons with a permanent pen such as a Pigma pen (I might go for this)
