## **Card Making Directions**

There are two types of cards that we made. The first is to showcase the Kaffe fabric motif to make the card.

Use the acrylic template laid over the fabric and center any flower or motif that you want to feature. Make a rough cut approx 1/2 inch around the template. Adhere the fusible to the back side of this piece. When cooled, use a rotary cutter & make a nice smooth cut of this fused piece, around the template. Remove the paper from the fused piece & fuse this to the front of the card.



For the 2nd type of card - the appliqué cards, we used the same technique for the base layer as above. Similarly, a rough cut slightly larger than the paper appliqué template, apply the fusible, use a light box or a window to trace the design to the back of the fused fabric — either onto the fusible or the paper affixed to the fusible. As you begin to make the cards, and get a feel for the fusible product, that you'll find a method to make the appliqué style cards that works best for you.

For the appliqué card, use a light box or a glass top dinette table with a light under it, to trace the appliqué designs on the fusible product. Cut the fusible slightly larger than the design. Separate the fusible product as instructed on package. Fuse onto back side of fabric. Cut on design lines. Fuse pieces to card which has the background fabric fused to it. Some appliqué pieces may be placed slightly under other appliqué pieces before fusing, for example the legs of the chicken are placed slightly under the chicken body.
