

The above illustration shows a layout for the 73 " x 90 " "Dorothy" version of the modified Blooming Nine Patch. The RED lines illustrate the first three of the 26 diagonal rows of the quilt top. The YELLOW lines indicate how the sides are trimmed after the rows are assembled and thoroughly pressed. The two corner triangles are the added after the rows are sewn together. It usually needs these corners to be trimmed and "squared up."
