



## Mauve Log Cabin

Based on Stone Log Cabin (Quilts In Italy) by Kaffe Fassett

Quilt: 67" x 81"

### Cutting Directions:

Center: Charlotte – Pastel; cut center 16½" x 24½"

Ring #1: Shot Cotton – Lupine ⅓ yard

Cut side borders cut 2" x 24½" and top/bottom borders 2½" x 19½"

Ring #2: Regal Fans – Pastel 1 yard

Cut side border at 4½" x 30" (approx.)

Top & bottom at 4½" x 28" (approx.)

Ring #3: Aboriginal Dots – Wisteria ⅓ yard

Cut side borders at 2¼" x 38" (approx.)

Top & bottom borders at 2¾" x 32" (approx.)

Ring #4: Shadow Flower – Contrast 1½ yards

Cut side borders at 7" x 45" (approx.)

Top & bottom borders at 7" x 48" (approx.)

Ring #5: Brassica – Magenta 1⅝ yds

Cut side borders at 4¾" x 56" (approx.)

Top & bottom borders at 5¾" x 54" (approx.)

Ring #6: Mad Plaid – Grey ½ yard

Cut side borders at 2½" x 66" (approx.)

Top & bottom borders at 2½" x 58" (approx.)

Outside Border: Japanese Chrysanthemum – Magenta 2 yards

Sides at 5½" x 70" (approx.)

Top & bottom borders at 6½" x 68" (approx.)

Binding: ⅝ yard of Spot – Guava, or Shot Cotton – Pistachio. Cut 8 strips at 2½" x WOF.

Backing – 5 yards

This is a simple quilt to assemble, however, each border needs to be smoothed, pinned and stitched carefully (walking foot or dual feed is recommended) over the previous, so that the borders do not become wavy or too tight and distort the quilt top. Extra fabric is included in cutting of the length of these rings or borders and needs to be trimmed after stitching. The lengths of the subsequent rings or borders are approximate (shown in magenta color) & should be doublechecked before cutting. The side borders are affixed first, then the top and bottom borders.
