I've been talking with many of you about starting some different activity clubs. Well, I've got the first one ready to go.

This first club will be our <u>Go! Getters</u>, focusing on **AccuQuilt Go! cutters & dies**. The second Tuesday of each month we'll host club meetings with two different sessions available: 1:30pm-4:00pm (afternoon group) or 5:30pm-8:00pm (evening group). The monthly fee is \$20/session and includes a free Go! pattern, door prizes, and, of course, Fun!

Each month will feature tips & tricks on getting the most out of your AccuQuilt Go! cutter, cutting out that month's project, and some months we may even have time to start sewing those projects. The first 30 minutes of each session will be more social so you have time to meet your fellow Go! enthusiasts and participate in some Q&A. At the top of the hour (2pm or 6pm) we'll get into the proper usage of your cutter/dies, discuss the month's project goals, and cut out the project.

The introductory meeting, February 14th, covers getting your cutter out of the box. You'll bring your cutter and some of your dies to practice with (not all of your dies because I know some of you have a LOT!) There will be no project in February...we're just trying to get you comfortable with the cutter and the proper techniques.




