



Our Go! Getters club will focus on AccuQuilt Go! cutters & dies. The second Tuesday of each month we'll host club meetings with two different sessions available: 1:30pm-4:00pm (afternoon group) or

5:30pm-8:00pm (evening group). The monthly fee is \$20/session and includes a free Go! pattern, door prizes, and, of course, Fun!

The introductory meeting, February 14th, covers getting your cutter out of the box. You'll bring your cutter and a few of your more basic dies to practice with (but not all of your dies because I know some of you have a LOT!) There will be no specific project in February...we're just trying to get you comfortable with the cutter and the proper techniques.

Each month will feature tips & tricks on getting the most out of your AccuQuilt Go! cutter, cutting out that month's project, and some months we may even have time to start sewing those projects. The first 30 minutes of each session will be more social so you have time to meet your fellow Go! enthusiasts and participate in some Q&A. At the top of the hour (2pm or 6pm) we'll get into the proper usage of your cutter/dies, discuss the month's project goals, and cut out the project.

You do not have to own a Go! cutter to participate in this club...but I'm pretty sure you'll want one once you see how better cuts make better quilts®. #ccgogetters


