May is anniversary month...and we're changing things up.

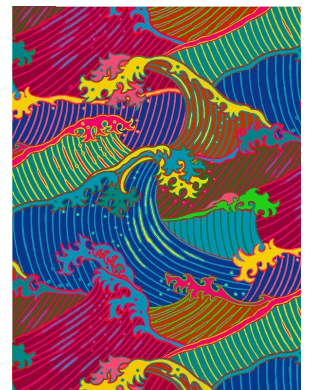
This month we **celebrate 10 years** of *Adina's* Cloth Carousel. Wow...has it really been that long? (Honestly, there have been a few times that it's felt like more, but most days it seems like it's all still so new.) Also, we're celebrating being in our Vacaville location for three years. So you know what that means? It's time to change things up!

During May you'll see lots of moving things around. We've already started with the yarn area, creating longer aisles so you don't have to work around the obstacles. We're consolidating the yarn notions to be closer together to save you (and us) some steps. Next up we'll rearrange the book/pattern area and its orientation with what we refer to as the 'yarn tables'. You'll then see some fabric cabinet relocation and a move of our Accuquilt and thread departments. Our ultimate goal is to get the Handi Quilter longarm machines out on the sales floor (where the batik fabric is now) for easier access to quilt our samples, for machine demonstrations, and to allow space for future training opportunities (maybe even the occasional rental if I can figure that part out). Just be patient with our mess...we'll have it fixed up in no time!

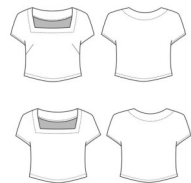
S Square Neck Top
