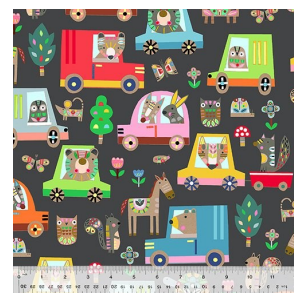


Creative Grids has rulers for Lefties!!
