

Dinosaur Quilt

In this class we will make Elizabeth Hartman's adorable dinosaur quilt. The first class will focus on cutting and sewing tips, and we will complete the plants. In classes 2-5 we will complete the 4 dinosaur designs, one in each session.

For class #1, we will spend some time cutting and sorting our fabric for the project, and then we will sew the Cycad, Vine and Fern pieces. **We'll cut out our fabric in class, but please bring all of your fabric to class the first day.**

Class #2 is Brachiosaurus, Class #3 is Tyrannosaurus, Class #4 is Stegosaurus and Class #5 is Triceratops.

Required Materials:

- Dinosaurs Quilt pattern by Elizabeth Hartman
- Fabric to make either the smaller quilt or the larger quilt. Note that the fabric requirements for this pattern are pretty generous, so the black and white can come from your stash – you only use very small amounts. Or you can share the 1/8 yard with your friends. Also, you will have a lot of fabric left over from your fat quarters. If you want to use scraps from your stash, refer to page 4 to see how much fabric is actually used for each dinosaur or plant.
- Sewing machine with power cord and foot pedal. Don't forget a new needle for a new project! If you have a quarter-inch foot that you like, please bring it.
- Print out and cut out the letter tags, and bring enough small ziplock bags or wonder clips for each alphabet letter. You have to mark your pieces with this pattern – there is no way to remember or keep track of them without some help.
- Cutting tools – rotary cutter with your favorite small to medium ruler and a small cutting mat (recommended). I like a 6" square or a 2 ½ x 12" size for cutting out all of the small pieces. There are cutting mats to use in the classroom, but it would be helpful to bring your own mat.
- Your own travel iron or small iron and wool mat. There are a LOT of small pieces and you need to press a lot of seams as you go. There are irons in the classroom, but you will be constantly up and down.
- Sewing notions – pins, seam ripper, thread snips/scissors, thread for piecing.
- Pencil or frixion marker for marking your fabric.
