

Elizabeth Hartman Club

In this class we will work on patterns designed by Elizabeth Hartman. Each person will work on their own project – there is no set agenda and you can drop in and out each month as you wish. Come work on your project and get some help if you need it, or just use the time and company to get your quilt finished in the company of friends.

Suggested Materials:

- Any pattern by Elizabeth Hartman
- Fabric for your pattern – or you can use the group to help you pick fabrics and buy what you need in class
- Sewing machine with power cord and foot pedal. Don't forget a new needle for a new project! If you have a quarter-inch foot that you like, please bring it.
- Print out and cut out the letter tags, and bring enough small ziplock bags or wonder clips for each alphabet letter. You have to mark your pieces with her patterns – there is no way to remember or keep track of them without some help.
- Cutting tools – rotary cutter with your favorite small to medium ruler and a small cutting mat (recommended). I like a 6" square ruler or a 2 ½ x 12" size for cutting out all of the small pieces. There are cutting mats to use in the classroom, but it would be helpful to bring your own mat.
- Your own travel iron or small iron and wool mat. There are a LOT of small pieces and you need to press a lot of seams as you go. There are irons in the classroom, but you will be constantly up and down.
- Sewing notions – pins, seam ripper, thread snips/scissors, thread for piecing.
- Pencil or frixion marker for marking your fabric on those diagonal lines.
