

Garden Party Table Runner

Join me in making a fun scrappy table runner featuring tea cups around a table. It was designed by the same pattern designer as the Wonky Tree Runner and uses the same triangle ruler. It is a lot of fun to make and you can add an improv touch with the tea cup handles if you please.

The pattern makes a runner with 10 tea cups. Make more for a fun cupboard quilt!

Required Materials:

- Sewing machine in good working order (remember your foot pedal and power cord!)
- Quarter inch foot
- Rotary cutter and your favorite ruler(s)
- Pins and seam ripper
- Thread (extra bobbin is a good idea)
- Cut Loose Coffee Break Pattern (CLPKAL012)
- Creative Grid Spider Web Ruler (CGRKA6)

Fabric:

- 5 background fabrics: fat quarter or 1/3 yard
- 10 fabrics for cups: 6 inches by 15 inches of each fabric
- Optional scraps for variety: Strips of one inch or wider or six inch squares
- 1/3 yard for inner sashing
- 1/3 yard for outer border
