

Improv Basics

Have you wanted to try your hand at improv quilting? Bring your sense of curiosity and play, as well as some fabric and your sewing machine and we'll get you started. This class will cover improv curves, inset skinny lines and some other improv basics.

Required Materials:

- Sewing machine in good working order (remember your foot pedal and power cord!)
- Quarter inch foot
- Rotary cutter and your favorite ruler(s)
- Pins and seam ripper
- Thread (extra bobbin is a good idea)
- Optional: Marker (for improv I suggest ChacoPen Blue with Eraser, Clover #5013)

Fabric Requirements:

Bring 6 to 10 fabrics you love (minimum half yard cuts) and a few other fabrics you like with them. Beloved scraps can be a great source of inspiration so feel free to bring scraps to play with. Bring enough fabric to have choices but not so much that you are overwhelmed.
