

Mushroom

This class will focus on making a pair of mushrooms from the Forest Fungi pattern. We will do the large and the small mushroom. This pattern is not paper pieced but you will get practice in precision stitch and flip sewing.

Required Materials:

- Sewing machine in good working order (remember your foot pedal and power cord!)
- Quarter inch foot
- Rotary cutter and your favorite ruler(s)
- Pins and seam ripper
- Thread (extra bobbin is a good idea)
- Pattern: Forest Fungi by Pen + Paper Patterns
- Optional: A smaller ruler such as Creative Grids 2½ by 18½ (CGR218) or Creative Grids 3½ by 18½ (CGR318) (handy for small measurements)

Fabric:

Fabric requirements are listed on the pattern if you want to do a quilt

If making one pair of mushrooms , you need the following:

- ¼ yard background
- For big mushroom
 - ¼ yard for cap if directional or 4" strip if not
 - 2½" square for "gills" (inside of mushroom)
 - 4" square for spots
 - 4" WOF strip for stem
- For little mushroom
 - 7" square cap
 - 2" square for "gills" (inside of mushroom)
 - 5" square for stem (can get it out of the fabric for big mushroom stem if you want to use the same fabric)

Bring leftovers from cutting in case of mistake!
