

Plaidy Cake

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Skill Level: Confident beginner and up

Supplies needed: (Class supplies are 10% off at Cloth Carousel)

- Plaidy Cake pattern by Cluck Cluck Sew
- Sewing machine in good working order (remember your pedal and power cord!)
- Thread
- “Plaid” fabrics for the size quilt you wish to make (see pages 1 and 2 in pattern)
 - ❖ **NOTE:** The **layer cake** option for this quilt allows for **no mistakes** in cutting. Fat quarters and scraps are more forgiving.
 - ❖ **IDEA:** Mix it up! You can use a combination of layer cake pieces, fat quarters, **and** scraps, so long as you have enough strips from everything combined. To figure out how many strips you need, look at the “scraps” chart on page 2 of the pattern for the size quilt you want to make.
- Background fabric for the size quilt you wish to make (see chart on page 2 in pattern)
- Ruler (12x12 size is ideal)
- Rotary cutter
- Basic sewing supplies, to include a new needle for your machine and an extra bobbin or two
- OPTIONAL: 18” x 24” cutting mat for your table
Note: *This is highly recommended to reduce wait times at the cutting tables*
- OPTIONAL: Baggies to organize your pieces. I get mine at the dollar store. Sandwich or quart size both work well.

Before Class:

1. Cut your BACKGROUND fabric per the pattern.
2. WAIT UNTIL CLASS to cut the “plaid” fabrics.
3. Consider making a photocopy of your pattern if you want to keep the original clean. But don’t make a photocopy of someone else’s pattern! (Please respect the pattern designer’s copyright.)
