

Running with Scissors (a ByAnnie Pattern) class taught by Annette Blandin

You'll be amazed how many sewing notions fit into this bag! Places for scissors, marking tools, spare sewing needles, even some small rulers!

Materials needed are listed on the back of the pattern.

I used: two-sided fusible bosal instead of Soft and Stable; SF101 (fusible interfacing); Clear 16-gauge vinyl; byAnnie zippers by the yard; Glide thread for sewing (it's stronger than my usual Aurifil...)

Homework

Please Come prepared...

Decide on your fabrics and placement

Read page 1 of your pattern (general instructions)

Please copy the page with the labels (the last page in your pattern) and cut out the labels.

Please complete section **I (Cut and Quilt) A, B, and C** on page 2 of your pattern (or longarm the yardage and then cut)

Please seal all edges (sew around each piece 1/8" from edge) of the main-foam-lining sandwich

Attach the corresponding labels to the fabric pieces

Running With Scissors

This handy zip-up Tool Case stores and carries rotary cutters, scissors, and more. A variety of easy-to-access pockets in vinyl, mesh, and quilted fabric can be customized to fit the tools you use and love.

We also recommend the companion pattern *Take A Stand* (sold separately) for totes in two sizes specially designed to use as a base on which to prop the case for easy access or to carry the case and more.

Tool Case

9½" H x 12½" W x 1½" D closed

12½" H x 20½" W open

SUPPLIES NEEDED

Main fabric [®] (body of case/tote, pockets)	¾ yard
Lining fabric [®] (lining of case/tote, pockets)	¾ yard
Coordinating fabric [®] (bindings, straps, handle, zipper pulls)	¾ yard
ByAnnie's Soft and Stable ^{®*} (stabilizer for case and tote)	36" x 58" SS1036/SS2036
Fusible interfacing [*] SUP179	7" x 12½"
Mesh fabric [*] (inner pockets) SUP209	4" x 13½"
Vinyl [*] (inner pockets) SUP151	12" x 12½"
Handbag zippers* to match fabric ZIP24, 30, 40 or ZIPYD	Two 30" or longer double-slide zippers and One 40" or longer double-slide zipper
TIP: Pattern includes instructions for using double-slide handbag zippers to make all the zippers needed for each project.	
Polypyro strapping, 1"** SUP164-1	¾ yard
Fold-over elastic, 20mm* SUP211-2	¾ yard
Thread to match fabrics	SoFine #50 polyester thread

[®]Avoid directional fabrics until you understand the process. Additional yardage and different construction methods may be required to use directional fabrics.

^{**}On the cover models, we used a fat quarter of a 4th fabric for the borders and center facing.
