

Seasonal Paper Piecing: Fall

Add a seasonal touch to your home or give a seasonal gift with a quick and easy paper piecing project! Make this funky black cat or another seasonal paper pieced design. Traditional paper piecing and paperless paper piecing methods will be demonstrated and most students will walk away with at least one finished seasonal block, maybe even a finished pillow.

Required Materials:

Foundation Paper for paper piecing

Basic sewing materials:

- Sewing machine in good working order (don't forget your cord!)
- Rotary cutter and your favorite ruler
- Pins and seam ripper
- Thread (extra bobbin is a good idea)

Optional: Pillow Form

Book: Paper Piecing All Year Round by Mary Hertel

This book is a treasure trove of seasonal paper pieced projects. "Betcha can't make just one!" (I'm already working on my third.)

Homework To Do Before Class

Pick a September, October or November project pattern from the book.

Make the number of copies required for your pattern on foundation paper.

Note: You can enlarge the copies a little if you'd like a slightly larger design. I enlarged mine using the letter to legal setting on the copying machine.

Fabric requirements are described for each pattern in the book. Bring the fabric required for the pattern you pick, a little extra if you enlarge the pattern.
