

Take Four!

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Take four fat quarters, a bit of thread, some sewing magic, and create four fun place mats for your table! Can you sew a seam? Then you can make these. Students will assemble four place mat tops in class. Ideal for beginners and confident beginners, and also for experienced quilters looking for a quick and fun project!

Skill Level: All

Supplies needed: (Remember Cloth Carousel offers 10% off class supplies!)

- ☐ Take Four! pattern by Cary Flanagan, published by Jambearies (pattern # CF224)
- ☐ Sewing machine in good working order (remember your pedal and power cord!)
- ☐ Walking foot for your machine (strongly recommended)
- ☐ Neutral thread to assemble your place mats
- ☐ Fabric:
 - ✓ Pick ***one of the following two options*** to make four place mats:
 1. If you want all four backings to be the same:
 - Four fat quarters of coordinating fabrics for place mats
 - One yard for backing
 2. If you want each backing to be different:
 - Four half-yards of coordinating fabrics
- ☐ 6" x 24" ruler
- ☐ Rotary cutter
- ☐ Basic sewing supplies, to include a new needle for your machine and an extra bobbin or two
- ☐ OPTIONAL: 18" x 24" cutting mat for your table

Note: This is highly recommended to reduce wait times at the cutting tables

Homework: Because we will be marking up your pattern in class, consider making a photocopy of your pattern if you want to keep the original clean. But...don't make a photocopy of someone else's pattern! (Please respect the pattern designer's copyright.)
