# Daytripper II Crossbody Case

Pattern Requirement: Daytripper II Crossbody Case, a by Annie pattern

### Fabric Requirements:

- ¾ yard main (outer bag and pockets)
- ½ yard bag lining
- 1/4 yard coordinating for strap, tabs, zipper pulls
- ½ yard soft and stable
- ½ yard lightweight fusible interfacing
- Handbag zippers 30" (minimum) double slide (2 Pulls)

#### Hardware:\*

- **Webbing**: you will need 2 yards of 1" webbing, two 3/4" D- rings, two 1" swivel hooks and one 1" Slider bar
- *Fabric*: two ¾" D-rings, two 1" swivel hooks, one 1" slider bar and one 1" square or rectangular ring
- \* Choose either webbing or fabric for your straps

## **Sewing Supplies:**

- Working sewing machine, with foot pedal and power cord
- 1/4" foot, zipper foot and a walking foot
- Extra machine needle, cotton coordinating thread, Wonder clips and/or long straight pins, seam ripper, scissors, fabric marking pen, ruler

### Homework:

Page 1 in the pattern instructions has very detailed cutting directions. Be sure to check off the boxes as you cut. Pay close attention to directional fabric instructions.

Cut your main fabric, lining fabric, soft and stable and interfacing.

### Strap:

If you are making a fabric strap: cut two 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 34" strips of coordinating fabric, two 3x3" tabs, two 1x12" zipper pulls\* If you are making a webbing strap: bring 2 yards of webbing, cut two 3x3" tabs and two 1x12" zipper pulls\*

\*zipper pulls are optional, I did not use them
