

Disappearing Block Quilt



Fabric purchase

Dark fabric	1/3 yard
Background fabric	1 yard – will also be <i>first border</i> .
Accent fabric	½ yard of one fabric or 12 10" layer cakes or *Stash that you can get 4 - 3.5" squares from each – 12 colors into 48 squares. *Or.....48 3.5" squares of multiple fabrics. Make it scrappy!
Second border	¼ yard – I used the dark fabric (buy ½ yd if you want more than .5" border.)
Third border	¾ yard (can match one of the fabrics, dark or your choice).
Binding	½ yard (your choice – matching dark fabric or outer border.)
Backing	3 yards with horizontal seam

Cutting prior to class!

- Dark fabric: Cut 2 x 6.5" WOF strips.
Subcut into 12 - 6.5" x 6.5" squares
- Middle Border: Cut 6 – 1" x WOF strips or *width of your choice*.
- Light fabric: Cut 8 x 3.5" WOF strips
Subcut: 48 3.5" x 6.5" rectangles.
- Inner border: Cut 5 – 2" x WOF strips
- *From the layer cake / scraps or third fabric:
You want 48 3.5" squares from whatever you have chosen to use.
- Outer border: Cut 6 4.5" x WOF strips

Class supplies

- **Rotating cutting mat – will make cutting easier.**
- Rotary cutter with NEW blade.
- Cutting ruler – at least 4" x 14"
- Sewing machine in good working order. (Please be comfortable using your machine.)
- 1/4" patchwork foot on machine.
- Sewing thread for project and bobbin ready.
- Sewing pins & seam ripper.
- Fabric marking pen or pencil.
- Sewing scissors.
- New machine needles “just in case”
