

Jelly Roll Rug

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Before class: Sew all fabrics together on the diagonal, end to end. I like a heavily patterned fabric in the middle and a dark fabric on the outside because that takes the hardest wear and dirt. Sew the lengths with the center first and the dark last. Flat fold the finished length. If you look at the flat side of the jelly roll, you will get a good idea of what your finished rug will look like.

Supplies:

Pattern: Jelly Roll Rug

Fabric: One Jelly Roll

2 1/2" batting roll, 50 yards

Clover Fabric Tube Maker

90/14 topstitch needle

Thread. Polyester will be stronger. I like Glide and it comes in many decorative colors. It is available at Cloth Carousel. Wind at least 2 bobbins.

Snips or small scissors to cut threads, seam ripper

Sewing machine with full bobbin, new needle **Your machine needs to be able to do a zigzag stitch

Table extension for your sewing machine

Power cord, foot peddle and instruction guide
