

Mock Cable Sock

Class taught by Annette Blandin

Materials: My own pattern; I'll give it to you at class

- Fingering weight sock yarn (100g, about 400 yds for a **pair**)
Plain yarn with a twist (not single ply!) is better, you want your work to be the star
- Needles: set of DPNs US size 1½ (2.5 mm) Feel free to use magic loop, 9" circs, Addi Flip or 2 circulars, if you're familiar with that method
OR size to obtain gauge (optional: plus one size bigger for upper shaft)
- Stitch marker
- Tapestry needle
- Measuring tape

Gauge: 32 stitches = 4" in stockinet stitch (on smaller size needles)

Homework: -Please check your gauge, (before and after laundering your gauge patch)

- Measure your foot at the ball-of-the-foot just before the pinkie toe (bare foot) at the ankle, and the length of your foot (assuming you're making this for you)
