

# The Scout Tee

The Scout is a woven t-shirt with cap sleeves and scoop neck. It's fitted at the shoulders and falls into a more relaxed shape below the bust. Perfect on its own for spring and summer and a great layering piece under blazers and cardigans the rest of the year. There are two size ranges for this shirt pattern – 0-18 and 14-32 (which has darts).

Techniques involved include straight seams, applying bias binding, setting sleeves and basic hemming. While you do not need garment sewing experience to take this class, **YOU MUST KNOW HOW TO SEW** already.

## **Session 1:**

A quick class where we will discuss fit, fabric selection, making a muslin and tracing the pattern. We will not be sewing this session, however you should have your pattern and preferably have your measurements written down for us to plan for the size you want to make. Mel can help with measurements if needed. We will also discuss options for fabric and how much you need. You should plan to cut your fabric prior to the second session.

## **Session 2:**

Students will construct their shirt. Ideally, students will come to session 2 with their fabric pieces cut out so they can accomplish as much construction as possible in class.

## **Supply List: Class supplies are 10% off when purchased at Cloth Carousel**

- \* Scout Tee Pattern
- \* Depending on size, anywhere from 1.5-2.5 yards of fabric (see pattern for details)
- \* **FABRICS MUST BE PRE-WASHED PRIOR TO CUTTING**
- \* Coordinating thread
- \* 2 yards of Pattern Ease
- \* Seam gauge
- \* Pins
- \* Scissors
- \* Seam ripper
- \* Marking pen or pencil
- \* Sewing machine: don't forget your power cord and foot pedal
- \* Additional bobbins and sewing machine needles
