

Clam Up Zippered Pouches

In 5 sizes!

This a potato chip project... “bet you can’t make just one!”

Supplies needed: As per pattern!

Note on -Fabric: Smaller prints may be more effective for the smaller pouches. I love how the bigger pouches with bold colors turned out!

-Foam: By Annie’s soft and stable gives body to your project. I also tried (and liked!) the fusible foam (Bosal) for even more body

-Zippers: The pattern is written for zippers by Annie. The zippers-by-the-yard are more cost-effective... Both are available at the Cloth Carousel in an amazing array of colors!

Homework/Class-prep: please prepare your pattern templates. I just copied mine onto regular paper and cut them out. (2 for large; 4 for extra-large. Taped together)

I suggest you also make a copy of page 8;

Bring to class: Your usual sewing supplies including $\frac{1}{4}$ “ foot and regular sewing foot (A foot)

A jeans needle (100/16) is very helpful

-Thread to match main fabric and to topstitch the grab-tabs

-Marking tools (pen pencil, chalk...)

-Pins and binding clips

The pattern comes with a unique code for an online tutorial!
