THE BASICS

I am very excited to introduce you to the world of circular knitting. Whether you have attempted already or are thinking, "umm what are double-pointed needles?". You'll learn the basics of joining your work in the round and using some new tools that make knitting in the round so much fun. This will open up the door to many new knitted items in your future, like hats, cowls, socks, and even sweaters.

For this class, I have selected what I have found are good quality, affordable and user-friendly products. So, rather than send you to many different stores to get supplies, I have stocked In Between Stitches with the supplies you would need.

Even better, I have put kits together for my students with all the required supplies listed below. These class notion kits come at a discounted rate vs. purchasing the items separately. All you have to do is select the yarn color of your choice, add the notions kit, and "boom," you are ready for the class.

MATERIALS NEEDED

1 "Learning to Knit in the Round" Class Notions Kit

***Kit includes all required notions & needles listed below. Just choose one skein of either yarns below in the color of your choosing and your all set for the class.**

- 1 skein of Dk weight yarn:
Madelinetosh Farm Twist, Tosh DK or Wool & Cotton
West Yorkshire spinners Fleece DK
Berroco Remix, Summer Seseme for a wool alternative

Included in notions kit:

- 1 set of Knitters Pride US 6 Double Pointed Needles
- 1 set Clover Stitch Holders (Cable Needles)
- 1 Knitters Pride 16" Interchangeable Needle Cord
- 1 Knitters Pride Dreamz US 4 Special Interchangeable Tips
- 1 Knitters Pride Dreamz US 6 Special interchangeable Tips

Supplies to have on hand:

- Snips or small scissors to cut yarn
- Susan Bates Fix-it tool or crochet hook
- A couple stitch markers
- Tapestry needle for weaving in ends
- Pencil or Pen for taking notes, I will be providing handouts.
