Please read all instructions before beginning this project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the pattern update QR code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together
SNF = Stitch and Flip

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics from the Twilight Creatures collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) 5-15360-42 5-Inch Stacker
1 yard C15360-STORM Main
1 ¾ yards C15363-ICE Scenery
1 ¼ yard C605-NAVY Shabby (includes binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies
1 ⅞ yards WB200-CHAMBRA Y Shades Wide Back Backing
Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



5-Inch Stacker


Select (36) 5" × 5" squares. Label as A.



Storm Main

Cut (6) 5" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 5" × 58 ½" strips. Label as B.
(2) 5" × 49 ½" strips. Label as C.



Ice Scenery

Cut (12) 3 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:

(36) 3 ½" × 9 ½" rectangles. Label as D.
(36) 3 ½" × 3 ½" squares. Label as E.

Cut (6) 2 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:

(12) 2 ½" × 15 ½" rectangles. Label as F.



Navy Shabby

Cut (6) 3 ½" × WOF strips; subcut:

(72) 3 ½" × 3 ½" squares. Label as G.

Cut (1) 2 ½" × WOF strip; subcut:

(4) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as H.

Cut (6) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

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SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in its abbreviated form.

STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Flip the smaller piece away from the larger piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.




BLOCK ASSEMBLY


1. Arrange (4) **A**-squares as shown below. Sew the pieces together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Four-Patch Unit. Repeat to make (9) total units.



2. Use the SNF method to make the unit shown below, referencing the diagram for quantity, proper placement, and orientation.




3. Arrange (4) **E**-squares, (4) SNF units, and (1) Four-Patch Unit as shown. Sew the pieces and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) block. Repeat to make (9) total blocks.



QUILT ASSEMBLY


4. Arrange (9) blocks, (12) **F**-rectangles, and (4) **H**-squares as shown below. Sew the blocks and pieces into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make the quilt center.



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5. Sew (1) **C**-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, sew (1) **B**-strip to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

6. Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Navy Shabby binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
