GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

HST = Half Square Triangle

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics from the Twinkle Little Star collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) P16306-PANEL Twinkle Little Star Pillow Panel

¼ Yard Each:

C16300-BLUE Main C16303-MIST Dream Skies

Additional Fabrics:

% yard C16303-PINK Dream Skies

- 1 yard C16300-MIST Main
- 1 ¼ yards C16301-CLOUD Counting Sheep
- 1 yard C16305-DENIM Jasmine Stars (includes binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies

1 % yards WB640-FROSTING Dapple Dot (wide back backing) Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Twinkle Little Star Pillow Panel

Fussy cut (4) 16 %" × 16 %" Panel squares, centered over the motifs.*

*Note: If the panel motifs do not reach the edge of the required cuts, add coping strips first and then trim to the required sizes.



Blue Main

Cut (1) 4 ½" × WOF strip. Subcut:

(5) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Label as A.



Mist Dream Skies

Cut (2) 3" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(20) $3" \times 3"$ squares. Label as B.



Pink Dream Skies

Cut (5) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(3) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 35" rectangles. Label as C.

(2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 27" rectangles. Label as D.



Mist Main

Cut (6) 5" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) $5" \times 59 \%"$ strips. Label as E.

(2) $5" \times 50 \%"$ strips. Label as F.



Cloud Counting Sheep

Cut (2) 4 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(2) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 27" rectangles. Label as G.

Cut (3) 3" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(40) 3" × 3" squares. Label as H.

Cut (7) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 35" rectangles. Label as I.

(40) 2 %" $\times 4 \%$ " rectangles. Label as J.



Denim Jasmine Stars

Cut (2) $3" \times WOF$ strips. Subcut: (20) $3" \times 3"$ squares. Label as K. Cut (7) $2 \%" \times WOF$ strips. Set aside for binding. Cut (5) $1 \%" \times WOF$ strips. Piece together end-toend; subcut:

(2) 1 ½" × 50 ½" strips. Label as L.

(2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as M.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in its abbreviated form.

2-AT-A-TIME HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE METHOD (HST)

Place (2) squares RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) square. Sew $\frac{1}{2}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to create (2) HSTs. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim HSTs to the indicated size.










BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew together (1) **C**-rectangle and (1) **I**-rectangle as shown below to make (1) strip set. Repeat to make (3) strip sets. Cut the strip sets into (40) total 2 ½"-wide segments. Label as Segment 1.

2. Repeat Step 1 using **G**-rectangles and **D**-rectangles to make a total of (20) 2 ½"-wide segments as shown below. Label as Segment 2.

3. Sew (2) Segment 1s together as shown below to make (1) Four-Patch Unit. Repeat to make (20) total units.

4. Sew (1) **J**-rectangle to the bottom of (1) Four-Patch Unit as shown below. Next, sew (1) Segment 2 to the right side to make (1) Corner Unit. Repeat to make (20) total units.

5. Gather the required pieces and use the 2-at-a-time HST method to make the units shown below, referring to the diagrams for quantity, proper placement, and orientation.

6. Arrange (2) B/H HST units and (2) K/H HST units as shown below. Sew the units together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Arrow Unit. Repeat to make (20) total units.



7. Sew (1) **J**-rectangle to the top of (1) Arrow Unit as shown below to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make (20) total units.



8. Arrange (4) Corner Units, (4) Side Units, and (1) **A**-square as shown below. Sew the units and square together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Star Block. Repeat to make (5) total blocks.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

9. Arrange (5) Star Blocks and (4) Panel squares as shown below. Sew the blocks and squares together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make the quilt center.



48 ½" × 48 ½"

10. Sew (1) M-strip to each side of the quilt center as shown in the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 5. Next, sew (1) L-strip to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew F-strips to the sides and E-strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

11. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Denim Jasmine Stars binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
