What does additional artwork mean?

Stitchless applique is a process using Steam A Seam 2. The applique pieces are traced with a pencil or printed with an inkjet printer onto SAS2. The applique pieces are placed onto the wrong side of the fabric. Press with hot dry iron on wool setting for 3-4 seconds. (Don't over heat!)

The basic artwork is lightly traced onto the applique pieces using a Pigma Micron pen .05 black. This is done <u>before</u> placing pieces onto the foundation fabric.

The lettering is traced onto the foundation fabric using the Pigma Micron pen .05 black, <u>before</u> adding the applique pieces.

Note: If hand embroidering or machine embroidering, it should be done <u>before</u> adding applique.



BEFORE shows the basic artwork traced onto applique pieces before placing onto foundation fabric. Wood planks have nail dots and leaves have vein lines added.

AFTER shows the additional artwork. Wooden planks, each plank the outside has been shaded and fine grainlines and knots were added. Leaves have shading on the edges and over the vein lines an then the vein lines are traced over again.

Shading with Graphic Micron brush, light cool gray and cool gray changes the color temperature to a warm color.
