$3 / 8$ yard $\quad$ Sewing Notions - Ivory (F) 1195-41
$3 / 8$ yard $\quad$ Scissors - Ivory (G) 1196-41
$3 / 4$ yard Meandering Stitch - Medium Brown (H) 1199-35
$41 / 2$ yards Sewing Motifs - Medium Brown (Backing) 1194-35

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel 36" - Ivory (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $341 / 2 " \times 411 / 2$ " rectangle centered on the panel.

From the Wood Grain - Dark Brown (B), cut:

- (4) $51 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $51 / 2$ " squares.
- (2) 2 " x $411 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(2) 2 " $\times 371 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Tossed Sewing Machines - Ivory (C), cut:
-(3) 5 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 " $\times 441 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 431 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Urban Legend - Red (D), cut:
-(3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 521 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) 2 " $x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 471 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

## From the Sewing Words - Ivory (E), cut:

- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 " $\times 501 / 2$ " strips.
-(3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " x $551 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Sewing Notions - Ivory (F), cut:

- (2) $51 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $51 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Scissors - Ivory (G), cut:

-(2) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $51 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Meandering Stitch - Medium Brown (H) -(7) 3 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (92) 3 " squares.

From the Sewing Motifs - Medium Brown (Backing), cut:
-(2) 78 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 68 " $\times 78^{\prime \prime}$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 411 / 2 "$

Fabric B strip to each side of the $341 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 411 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A panel. Sew (1) $2 " \times 371 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $361 / 2 " \times 431 / 2 "$ to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Place (1) 3 " Fabric H square on the bottom left corner of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric B square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 3).

3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 3" Fabric H square to the lower right corner of the $51 / 2 "$ Fabric B square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (22) Unit 2 squares total.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 6-9 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (12) Unit 3 squares, (10) Unit 4 squares, (2) Unit 5 squares and (2) Unit 6 squares.

6. Follow Figure 10 and sew together (6) Unit 2 squares, (3) Unit 3 squares and (3) Unit 4 squares to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

7. Follow Figure 11 and sew together (1) Unit 5 square, (5) Unit 2 squares, (3) Unit 3 squares, (2) Unit 4 squares and (1) Unit 6 square to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 8. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 431 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $5 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $471 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $2 " \times 551 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 " x $501 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
