Description: Looking for a stylish way to keep sewing supplies or other items organized? This Long & Skinny Zipper Pouch is a snap to make, and since any style or color of fabric can be used, you can make this fit your own unique personality! This zipper pouch requires just a small amount of fabric, which makes it a great project to make to use some of your stash of scraps, too! Great for stowing your rotary cutter, scissors and other long & skinny objects!!! You will make one for yourself....and another for a friend!!!

Finished Size: 6" wide (at the top opening) x 5 \(^3\kappa'\) high x 5" deep

Fabric Requirements:

Main Fabric Fat Eighths 6" x 18" main print (canvas/denim/quilting cotton)
Accent Fabric Fat Eighths 6" x 12" accent fabric (canvas/denim/quilting cotton)

Lining Fabric Fat Quarter or 1/4 yard cotton canvas or quilting cotton for lining

½ yard of SF101

Fat Eighths measures 9" x 21" Fat Quarter measures 18" x 21"

Supplies Needed for Evening of Class:

- Sewing machine with coordinating thread, appropriate needle, machine feet
- Rotary cutter
- Straight Pins/Wonder Clips
- Pencil
- Frixion pen or water soluble marker
- Seam Ripper (just in case)

HOMEWORK....There is a small amount of cutting for this project. Templates will be emailed to you directly a few days before class. Use the paper templates or make freezer paper templates. The following templates are needed: 1-exterior main, 1-reversed exterior main; 1 exterior accent, 1 reversed exterior accent. And one template for the lining.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Using the main exterior template, cut (1) from the main fabric.

Using the reversed main exterior template, cut (1) from the main fabric.

Using the exterior accent template, cut (1) from the accent fabric.

Using the reversed exterior accent template, cut (1) from the accent fabric.

Using the lining template, cut (2) lining pieces.

You will be fusing the interfacing during class time. If you want a sturdier pouch bring a (2) pieces approx.. 6" x 14" or (1/4 yard) of fusible fleece to fuse later to the exterior.

Bring all extra fabric and interfacing to class. Depending on the style of zipper you may have to make zipper tabs (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ").

This is a great project for the beginner as well as the experienced sewist!!
